Groundwork Hudson Valley's Get Fresh Yonkers Farmers' Market opens June 3 at Van der Donck Park, across from the Metro-North Yonkers station.

The market will run from noon to 5 p.m. weekly through Oct. 28 and this season it will feature hyper-locally grown produce and hydroponic vegetables from the Science Barge.

The market will also have produce from partnering farms like Peace and Carrots Farm of Chester, New York, Dagele Brothers Produce of Florida, New York, and Alex's Tomato Farm of Ossining.

Additionally, the market will sell pickles from Jersey Pickles and various baked goods from the youth of Mount Carmel Baptist Church, Pure Essential homemade soaps and oils, alternative healing workshops from Yonkers Wellness Center and handmade Mexican jewelry and goods from Sololi.
